Description:

The Engineer / Test & Evaluation Planner will:

- Work with a team of 5-7 individuals to support the Test and Evaluation portion of the Littoral Combat Ship Acquisition.
- Work with Subject Matter Experts to prepare documentation of test schedules, development testing and operational testing requirements, and provide updates to Test and Evaluation Master Plan (TEMP).
- Complete tasking under Government direction. Prepare and deliver presentations and briefings.
- Review, implement, and maintain plans and tracking mechanisms that map programmatic requirements to planned test events.
- Develop technical justifications in support of programmatic positions and decisions in support of planned test events.
- Coordinate with Fleet and other stakeholders to develop and promulgate a single integrated plan to support all test events.
- Provide support in researching, planning, and conducting and evaluating combat system integration and test and trial activities.
- Maintain awareness of ship schedules, casualty reports, material condition and readiness status in order to keep the Program Manager and Washington, DC based staff apprised of any impacts to mission or test events
- Develop briefings, reports, naval messages, and official correspondence on behalf of LCS T&E PAPM (PMS 501S)
- Track and manage actions for PMS 501S DPAPM
- Manage and make updates to Integrated Data Environment (IDE) for PMS 501S
- Prepare responses to reports and questions from stakeholders, including DOT&E and GAO
- Represent and provide support to PMS 501S for Combat Systems Ship Qualification Trial (CSSQT), Surface to Surface Missile Mod (SSMM), Aviation Certifications, Platform Planning and Commander, Operational Test and Evaluation Force (COTF) Meetings and various other test planning events and provide after action reports to keep the team informed of meeting results.

- Ability to prioritize multiple simultaneous tasks and effectively schedule required deliverables, meetings and follow-up actions
