Responsibilities & Duties

Work under the direction of a senior logistician to provide logistical support to the Naval Surface Warfare Center Panama City Division in their role as the Landing Craft Air Cushion (LCAC)/LCAC-100 In-Service Engineering Agent (ISEA).

- Provide logistics support involving revision of Provisioning, Technical, Configuration Management (CM), Life Cycle Support planning, Training Materials, operations and maintenance documentation, and Sustainment Documentation.
- Technical Manual (TM) support: Review and implement submitted Technical Manual Deficiency Evaluation Report (TMDERs) from Fleet users into the applicable LCAC Technical Manuals.
- Planned Maintenance System (PMS): Develop new Maintenance Index Pages (MIPs) and Maintenance Requirement Cards (MRCs) when new equipment is introduced or when need becomes known for existing equipment.
- Diminishing manufacturing sources and material shortages (DMSMS) Support: Review DMSMS documentation and provide comments to Government customer.

- General knowledge of Navy logistics requirements and a history of support for Navy logistics efforts.
- Able to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Well organized and flexible.
