Job Position: **Navigation Systems Programmatic Analyst**

**The Navigation Systems Programmatic Analyst will:**

- Liaise with a broad array of program stakeholders to solve difficult programmatic and technical issues; including but not limited to: PMS 505, IWS 6.0, IWS 8.0, Navy Surface Warfare Center (NSWC) field activities, In-Service Engineering Agents (ISEA), Technical Warrant Holders (TWH), Fleet organizations and LCS vendors.
- Evaluate existing and future LCS navigation systems to provide system integration recommendations with LCS Combat, C4I, and HM&E systems.
- Participate in Configuration Management Boards (CMB), Technical Interchange Meetings (TIM), Working Groups, Task Forces, and other relevant forums. Generate meeting deliverables, including After Action Reports (AAR). Document Action Items and track to closure.
- Participate in a broad array of system concept & design efforts, including engineering reviews of drawings, interfaces, and functional specifications against system requirements.
- Participate in science & technology studies, including engineering trade studies, capability / feasibility studies, impact assessments, performance evaluations, and other relevant activities.
- Participate in program office events such as: Milestone Reviews, funding reviews, planning meetings, and scheduling events.
- Provide timely review of interface control documents (ICD), Engineering Change Proposals (ECPs), Contract Data Requirements List (CRDLs), and other relevant products.
- Identify, coordinate and manage scheduled delivery and risk mitigation for Navigation Mission Systems Government Furnished Equipment (GFE) / Government Furnished Information (GFI) as identified by PMS 501M and PMS 501 Leadership
- Track certification and technical status of Contractor Furnished Equipment (CFE) for LCS 27AF.
- Support timely risk identification, analysis, reporting, and mitigation for LCS navigation systems.
- Generate & deliver timely status updates, weekly reports, schedule revisions, briefings, documents, procedures, plans, drawings, white papers, planning documents, and other relevant products as required.

- Bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Systems Engineering, Business Management, or equivalent military experience in Navigation Systems and how they relate to Combat and C4I Systems, such as Electronics Technician or Operations Specialist ratings
- DoD Secret Clearance
- Strong Problem-Solving skills.
- At least five to ten (5-10) years of experience in Navigation Systems and networks.
- Self-motivating, highly proactive, and professional demeanor.
