**Description:**

Able to perform as the Information Assurance Lead for the NAVSEA IDE, which is utilized by several NAVSEA Program Offices.

As the Information Assurance lead, you are responsible for developing and maintaining the Defense Support PMS 501/PMS 500 to maintain their Integrated Data Environment (IDE).

Responsible for the Certification and Accreditation of the IDE and provide support for daily operations of the IDE and interfacing with the IDE development team.

Must be familiar with the DoD standards guiding the development of Information Assurance (IA) policy, requirements, engineering and certification and accreditation.

Understanding of National Institute of Science and Technology (NIST) Security Controls.

Manage, create and process certification and accreditation packages in accordance with Risk Management Framework (RMF) standards working with program managers, system engineers and developers to obtain accreditation for U.S. Navy information system. Participate in all collaborations meetings and meetings with the Certification Authority (CA) and ODAA.

Assess, develop, and provide recommendations for Cybersecurity Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for the IDE

Develop IDE Change Requests for team review and approval.

Maintain Plan of Action of Management (POA&M) of open security findings. Ensure POA&M is current and reported to NAVSEA.

Retrieve ACAS scan results from VRAM system.

Use knowledge of Private Key Infrastructure (PKI) principles to implement and provide guidance regarding PKI implementation including CAC based authentication.

Manage Help Desk including creation and manage accounts on the IDE, including permissions for individual users, creations and manage access control groups, and establish and maintain menu items.

Liaison with customers for requirements for new applications. Relay those requirements to the appropriate developers.
