Position: LCAC Maintenance Technician USN

Background: If you are interested in supporting the US Navy by providing the maintenance, repair, and modification of Expeditionary Connectors to include but not limited to LCACs (both LCAC-1 class and LCAC-100 class) assigned to NSWC PCD, Naval Assault Craft Units (ACUs), and Naval Beach Units (NBU) in a role that involves meaningful and challenging projects - MSCorp has a great opportunity for you.

MSCorp currently supports the Navy as a prime contractor for the Naval Surface Warfare Center, Panama City Division (NSWC PCD) and the PMS 317 Amphibious Warfare group. In preparation to support both the Landing Craft Air Cushion (LCAC) and LCAC 100 Class Landing Craft maintenance and repair contract, MSCorp is looking for candidates to fill many positions.

Position Summary: In this role you will serve as a Maintenance Technician working on Hull and Mechanical maintenance, repair, and modifications. To apply for this position, one is not required to be able to perform all of the duties and responsibilities identified below.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform Non-destructive testing using liquid penetrant or other methods
- Perform composite repair support for fiberglass and carbon fiber components/systems.
- Perform scheduled craft maintenance following written/verbal process and procedures
- Know how to use a variety of hand tools, power tools, and wear safety gear.
- Perform welding on various materials such as aluminum, stainless steel, and Inconel
- Perform maintenance on Gas Turbine engines, Hull Systems, and Mechanical System
- Perform AC&R maintenance
- Fabricate assemblies from raw materials from blueprints and technical documentation
- Perform other maintenance duties as directed by the maintenance manager or task lead
